

Continuing the tradition of graduates of our school returning to teach Tamil to our youngsters, we have up to three of our former students teaching in our school




in various capacities. We hope to make a few of them permanent teachers during the coming years.

Accreditation

What is Accreditation and why is it important for CTS?

Accreditation is a voluntary process of self-regulation and peer review to assess the quality of institutions, programs and services, measuring them against agreed-upon standards and thereby assuring that they meet those standards. CTS is pursuing accreditation by AdvancED, an organization which provides accreditation to educational institutions around the globe.

Accreditation acknowledges a level of organizational competence that is comparable to other organizations accredited by the same accrediting body, viz., AdvancED. It also identifies areas in need of improvement and provides suggestions on how those improvements could be made.

By being deemed comparable to other accredited organizations, e.g., Wake County Public School System, education and credits received by students at CTS will qualify to be transferred as-is into their WCPSS transcripts.

Special committees with parents, teachers and members of the Board have been formed to lead the effort of formalizing the structures and collecting evidences needed to be presented to the AdvancED evaluators who will be visiting our school during the later part of April 2015. Upon completion of their evaluation, the evaluators will submit their accreditation recommendation to AdvancED which will make the formal accreditation decision during June 2015. We look forward to your unwavering support in our journey of continuous improvement of our school and Tamil language learning by our children.
